.67 acre lot at Hwy. 52 in Historic District purchased by Scott Roberts. The owner whom was not present at the meeting reports the home is unlivable and will need to be torn down and rebuilt – council would like owner to present his plans for the property at future meeting before discussing further

Park Upgrades and Restroom Updates: existing exit doors not included in contract – Mayor requested quote for replacing 3 exterior doors – discussion of other items not included in contract but needed – Kody Rylee made motion to approve additional \$500 for heaters plus installation in exterior bathrooms; second-Ricky Sutton; all in favor

Town Hall Restroom Project Update: Ricky Sutton gave status update of preparation – sump pump and power meter box to be moved – running water for sink in Frankum Building – adding back door to Frankum Building to be included – Ricky Sutton will schedule Hall County to run water and install meter - \$89,000 ARPA funds have been allocated to this project
