## **OLD BUSINESS:**

**DOT Downtown Parking Project Update:** The Department of Transportation officially began the road project regarding the parking lanes along the front of the city buildings. These areas are being used by vehicles as turning lanes which is a potential risk for accidents. This issue has raised concern among several city officials and citizens. The Town will wait to apply the blacktop and stripping in these problem areas once the DOT project is completed. This is being done in hopes of resolving the issues of the parking lanes along the front of the city buildings.

**Security Camera for Downtown Area:** The Mayor and Council discussed the need for two security cameras in the downtown area for added security. This will include the area behind the Gillsville Café. Jeff Perry made a motion for Evolve Technology to install two cameras in the amount of \$1,679.53. Todd Dale seconded.

Jeff Perry, Keith Segars, Todd Dale, voted in favor. Ricky Sutton abstained. Motion passed 3-1.

**Frankum Building Renovation:** The renovations being done by Eldridge Renovations are on schedule. The Mayor and Council discussed having an open house upon completion.
