- Park renovations were observed along with some damage to the building and a signed contract along with a \$100 cash damage deposit was put into effect in order to curtail damage.

NEW BUSINESS:

Compensation Resolution No. 0503-24 Status- Mayor Dale Stated that this is on the Governor's desk awaiting a signature.

Update on Park Renovation- Mayor Dale stated that he would like for the park flooring to be the next focus of the park renovations. It was agreed to bring flooring samples and prices to the next meeting.

Frankum Building Lighting- Lighting photos were passed around to the council and public. A chandelier was selected. It was voted that 2 chandeliers be placed as the central lighting, Keith Segars made a motion to accept the lighting choice, Todd Dale seconded. All council members present voted in favor. Motion passed.

Grass Cutting Bids- Grass cutting bids were open, and the lowest bids were chosen for downtown grass cutting, and park grass cutting. Jonathan Ervin got the bid for the Park Grass Cutting for \$245, and Dwayne Crocker got the bid for the downtown for \$225.

Website Update- The Frankum building is now available to rent for just \$300-\$350 per day and is on our website and social media pages. Upcoming Town Events have been posted to all social media, and our website. Sydney Segars' Gillsville Spring Market is coming on April 21st @ The Frankum Building, A Mother's Day Tea is being held @ The Frankum Building on May 11th, as well as a 3 Day Charity Event being held at the Gillsville Town Park on Memorial Day weekend.
