NEW BUSINESS:

Approval of January 12th, 2026, Minutes – Keith Segars made a motion to approve the January 12th, 2026, Minutes, Wade Dale seconded the motion, all council members present voted in favor of approving the January 2026 Minutes.

Blue Ridge Fence Estimate- The fence repairs were discussed, and it was decided to contact Turner, Wood and Smith to see if this may be covered by the insurance policy.

OLD BUSINESS:

Veteran Memorial Update- Mayor Sutton asked for an update on the progress of the Veterans memorial. Council member Wade Dale gave an update and said that work is progressing. The Town would like to have a Memorial Day Event to dedicate the Veterans Memorial. More discussion will follow.
